ELSTON 2002

*Elston derives its name from the village near Newark in Nottinghamshire where Elston Hall is renowned as the ancestral home of the Darwins of the noted 'Theory of Evolution.'
The nyvern symbol of the village also appears on the label.*

Elston 2002 was made from 100% Mendoza clone Chardonnay, hand harvested from vineyards adjacent to the winery between the 19th and the 23rd of March.

Following whole cluster pressing the settled juice was racked to barrel for the primary fermentation, a full secondary malolactic fermentation and maturation on lees. The wine was bottled in late January 2003.

Elston 2002 has a golden, green colour, displays aromas of stonefruit, citrus and toast, with butter, vanilla and nectarine flavours leading to a sustained, ripe finish.

Elston 2002 is an ideal partner for poultry and seafood with rich flavours, either from the food itself or because of the sauces accompanying it.

Elston 2002 will develop in bottle for 3-6 years from harvest.
