ELSTON 2003

*Elston derives its name from the village near Newark in Nottinghamshire where Elston Hall is renowned as the ancestral home of the Darwins of the noted 'Theory of Evolution.'
The nyvern symbol of the village also appears on the label.*

Elston 2003 is predominantly made from the Mendoza clone of chardonnay, supplemented with a little clone 95, hand harvested from our vineyards between the 10th and 27th of March.

The grapes were whole cluster pressed, cold settled, racked to barrel for primary and malolactic fermentation and then maturation on lees. The wine was bottled in late April 2004.

The Elston 2003 has a golden colour and tantalising aromas of ripe stonefruit, oatmeal and buttered toast. Its long palate introduces creamy flavours and textures, and indicates that this is a wine which will cellar impressively.

Elston 2003 is a great glass of full flavoured white wine and also matches with rich seafood, chicken, pork and pasta dishes.

Elston 2003 will continue to develop in bottle for 2-6 years from harvest.
