ELSTON 1992

*Elston derives its name from the village near Newark in Nottinghamshire where Elston Hall is renowned as the ancestral home of the Darwins of the noted 'Theory of Evolution.'
The nyvern symbol of the village also appears on the label.*

1992 Elston Chardonnay was harvested between the 24th March and the 4th April.

The hand-picked grapes were whole-cluster pressed, the resultant juice settled then fermented in oak, half of it being new.

The wine then aged on lees in barrel for a further nine months and was bottled January 1993.

1992 Elston Chardonnay has a full golden colour with green lights, an aroma of honey and pineapple and a lovely ripe palate with hints of smoke and integrated oak.

It has an ageing potential of 3-5 years from harvest.
