ELSTON 1995

*Elston derives its name from the village near Newark in Nottinghamshire where Elston Hall is renowned as the ancestral home of the Darwins of the noted 'Theory of Evolution.'
The nyvern symbol of the village also appears on the label.*

The grapes for Elston were hand harvested between the 20th and the 27th March.

They were pressed, settled, and the juice racked to new and used barrels for fermentation, following which the wine was aged and blended in the same barrels.

1995 Elston has a pronounced green-gold colour, an aroma of nectarines, pineapple and toast, and a long, rich palate finishing with a crisp, butterscotch edge.

The wine will continue to develop in bottle for 4-8 years after harvest.

1995 Elston is an ideal partner to rich, creamy seafood, poultry, and white meat dishes, as well as being a lovely aperitif.
