ELSTON 2001

*Elston derives its name from the village near Newark in Nottinghamshire where Elston Hall is renowned as the ancestral home of the Darwins of the noted 'Theory of Evolution.'
The wyvern symbol of the village also appears on the label.*

Elston Chardonnay was hand harvested between the 19th and 27th March.

Following pressing and settling, the juice was racked to 225 litre oak barrels for both primary and malolactic fermentation and aged for ten months before blending and bottling in early February 2002.

Elston 2001 has a pronounced golden green colour. It has aromas of ripe pineapple, honey and vanilla, concentrated biscuity, creamy flavours, and a long toasty background.

Elston 2001 is at its best when served with fresh, richly flavoured seafood's, white meats, and creamy cheeses.

It will develop and intensify in bottle for 4-6 years from harvest.
