COLERAÏNE '10.

Intense yet fine in the Medoc style. This is a classic Coleraïne - medium-bodied, fine, savoury and long.

COLERAÏNE '10 LIBRARY RELEASE LIMITED

A saturated magenta colour with concentrated aromas of blackcurrants, spice and dark, old fashioned roses. The palate opens with the dense, sweet, dark berry fruits indicative of a great year. The focus quickly turns to rich fine tannins that fill the mouth, leaving a lasting impression of a wine of significant ageing ability.
Development Potential: 10-15 years from harvest.

AWATEA '12 LIMITED

A ruby colour with lifted aromas of red cherry and boysenberry, with a background of chocolate, baked earth and cedar. The palate shows the same concentrated, syrupy red berry characters, with a touch of cocoa powder, and a fine, savoury, tannin frame that continues from the start right through to the long, refreshing finish.
Development Potential: Up to 10 years from harvest.

BULLNOSE '13 NEW RELEASE

The striking magenta colour is unusually deep, reflecting the great vintage. On the nose, beautiful aromas of black and red cherries and raspberries are infused with nutmeg, cinnamon spice and toasty oak. The palate is rich, ripe and juicy, echoing all the inviting aromas. There is great integration of the fruit and oak with the remarkably fine, even and supple tannins.
Development Potential: Up to 10 years from harvest.

Estate Vineyards MERLOT/CABERNETS '13

A bright crimson colour, with characters of plum, blackberry and apple compote, and an attractive cinnamon spice and bay leaf background. The classically structured palate shows sweet, ripe fruit flavours in great balance, with fine, dry tannin, leading to a supple, even finish.
Development Potential: Three to six years from harvest.

Estate Vineyards SYRAH '13

A dark crimson colour with complex characters of raspberry, red plum and boysenberry, together with notes of lavender, cinnamon and five spice. The concentrated palate is immediately syrupy in texture, and balanced by firm powdery tannins that provide great length to the sweet, red berry fruit flavours.
Development Potential: Two to four years from harvest.

Estate Vineyards GAMAY NOIR '14 NEW RELEASE

A bright, brilliant crimson, with an exquisite candy fragrance and a ripe, juicy palate that sparkles with raspberries, cherries and wild strawberries. Soft tannins and red berries lead to a fine, refreshing finish.
Development Potential: Two years from harvest.

ELSTON '13

A brilliant, pale lemon colour, with inviting aromas of golden grapefruit, toasted brioche, brazil nuts and popcorn. The palate shows an immediate character of ripe nectarine, lemon and nougat notes, together with both the sweetness and acidity of fresh pineapple contributing to its long, fine finish.
Development Potential: Five years from harvest.

ZARA '13 LIMITED

A pale gold colour with the classic apricot-scented character of serious viognier. Very complex notes of mandarin, nougat, jasmine, lychee and hazelnuts are also evident, and the palate is concentrated and soft, with a lovely, lingering mouth feel.
Development Potential: Three to four years from harvest.

CAPE CREST '13

A brilliant diamond-white colour with wonderful notes of ripe lime, white flowers and lemon curd. The palate shows great concentration of guava, toast and smoked figs, with great acid cut and precision. Its weight balance and sustained finish ensure Cape Crest '13 will develop over a decade or more.
Development Potential: 10 years from harvest.



Estate Vineyards CHARDONNAY '13

A bright green colour with gold highlights. It is fresh and expressive with white meadow flowers, hazelnut, white peach, green melon, and oat butter biscuit characters. The palate quickly builds in intensity with the rich citrus and ripe stonefruit flavours that are classically Hawke's Bay in a great year, leading through to a long, fine, finish.
Development Potential: Two to four years from harvest.

Estate Vineyards SAUVIGNON BLANC '14 NEW RELEASE

A brilliant pale straw colour with gold lights, an aroma of lime and exotic tropical fruit gives way to a succulent palate of ripe gooseberry, clover honey, passionfruit, currants and citrus. The finish is long, generous and finely balanced with a touch of lemon honey.
Development Potential: Two years from harvest.
